Adjutant's Report

The Col. D. H. Lee Martz Camp 10 of the Sons of Confederate Veterans held their May 2016 meeting on the 25th at the Rockingham County Administration Center.

At 7:00 pm Commander Phil Way called the meeting to order. Chaplain Sprinkle gave the invocation. Camp members gave the pledge of allegiance to the American flag and salutes to the Virginia and Confederate flags.

Lloyd Monger read the May treasurer's report. Most notable is the Confederate heritage proclamation with receipts of \$3560 leaving the project \$926.44 ahead this year. Tom Yeakle moved to accept the report as read. The motion was seconded and passed.
